

Classical Music Concert at Library

Marjorie Koharski, Neptune flutist and Keith Calmes, classical guitarist from Ocean Grove, will perform duo concerts on Sat., Sept. 17 at 2 p.m. at the Wall Public Library, located at 2700 Allaire Road in Wall and on Wed., Oct. 5 at 7 p.m. at Brick Library at 301 Chambersbridge Road in Brick Township.
